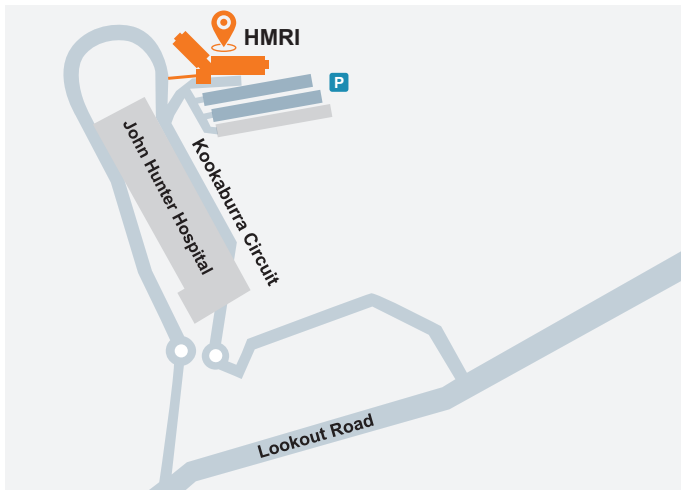

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What do I need to bring to my appointment?

A: Please bring along your Medicare card, original referral (if this was provided to you) and any old imaging that you think may be relevant.

Q: Can I drive home after my procedure?

A: If you are having a procedure such as a spinal injection or organ biopsy it is likely that you won't be able to drive home and will need to arrange alternate transportation. This will be discussed with you at the time of your booking. If you are only having a consultation, you will be able to drive yourself home.

Q: Will my procedure hurt? Will I be put to sleep?

A: All of our procedures are performed using local anaesthetic and are usually tolerated extremely well. Certain procedures may require a light sedation, this will be discussed with you at the time of making your booking if required.

Q: What are the out-of-pocket expenses?

A: Out-of-pocket expenses (if any) will have been discussed with you at the time of booking. If you are unsure, please contact one of our staff on the contact number above and they will be able to advise you accordingly.

Q: When will my Dr receive my results?

A: Results are sent to your referring doctor usually within 24 hours, all urgent results are prioritised. More complex imaging can take several days to report depending on the analysis required (cardiac MRI and CT for example).
